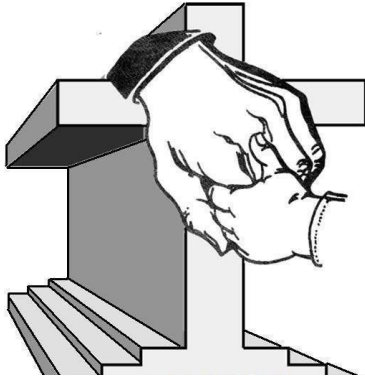

Youth & Family of all ages

Children's Haven International (CHI) provides a home and refuge to over 50 Mexican children from broken, abusive, or impoverished homes. Similar to a private foster system, CHI provides loving homes, structure, and education through the foundation of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. Rejoice Lutheran Church has sent teams 1-2 times per year for the last 15 years.

Cost: It costs about \$510 per participant for our trip. Each family is asked to contribute towards that fee both financially and through serving at our fundraising events.

Fee: \$275 total; \$100 non-refundable deposit due by September 30th, \$175 due April 15th

Fundraising Commitment: Each participant is expected to work a minimum of 12 hours or pay the full amount of \$510.

What's included: Transportation, lodging, meals at the Children's Haven site (Sunday night through Friday breakfast), and all programming.

What's not included: Meals during the drive to & from Mexico, any spending money for souvenirs, snacks, etc.

Registration is due by September 30th with \$100 to guarantee your spot.

Other details: Besides opportunities to bond during fundraising, our mission group will meet several times in the months ahead to prepare ourselves for the experience. Youth are expected to attend these meetings. Parents are asked to attend a spring parent meeting.
