## From Pastor Karlene Jung



Greetings from Louisville!

I am so excited to be joining you as your pastor in just a week or so. As we get to know each other, you'll learn that I have a calendar that, each month, focuses on a different word. I spend the entire month thinking about that word, journaling on it, and immersing myself in its meaning.

So, the word for September is *knowledge*. It's kind of a perfect word to introduce myself to you - as a seeker of knowledge. "Knowledge" in Greek is *gnosis*. It's a word that refers to what is known or understood, either through experience, perception, or revelation. Really our entire lives are about *gnosis*. About growing into who we are, who we have been called to be as children of God, and how we are to live out that life.

My life has been one of seeking that understanding. I grew up on a sheep ranch in north-central South Dakota, born into a *huge* family - I have about 75 first cousins. It was a great life on the prairie until my dad died unexpectedly when I was fourteen. You can imagine its impact on me. A few years later, at 19, I moved to Los Angeles - quite a culture shock. For ten years, I worked as a courtroom clerk for the L.A. County courts, then got involved in my local union. From there I began working as an organizer in the labor and social justice movements in So. California and along the south Texas border. I did this work for nearly 25 years. During this time, I also earned my undergrad degree in Labor Studies - Organizational Development and Growth.

I'm also a church musician. I learned piano at the age of 5 and the pipe organ in junior high - studying both in high school and college. My mom - a piano teacher and church organist - put me on the organ bench at the age of 13. So, as I worked in the courts and social justice movement, I also worked as a part-time Worship Director in two ELCA churches in the Los Angeles Foothills - directing choirs, accompanying worship, and, for a time, teaching children's music in an elementary day school. It was through *this* work where I began to experience that God was calling me to something new.

So, I began to work on my M.Div. at Fuller Seminary in Pasadena, intending to become a full-time worship director. Sometimes, though, the Holy Spirit has other plans for us. After a LOT of nudging and discernment (I'm a reluctant pastor!), I applied for candidacy in the Southwest California Synod. I completed my degree at Fuller, then moved to St. Paul for a year of Lutheran study at Luther Seminary and chaplaincy training. This was followed by another year of internship at Chatfield Lutheran Church, southeast of Rochester. I was ordained in 2017 and called, first, to Grace & Glory in Goshen, KY, then to a second church - Third/MOSAIC in Louisville. By the way, the correct pronunciation and dead-giveaway-that-you're-not-a-local-if-you-don't-pronounce-it-this-way is Lou-uh-ville! 😊

In the midst of these experiences, I was married and divorced, yet blessed with a pretty great son, Mike, who lives in Minneapolis, is a CPA, and works as a senior tax manager at Boulay in Eden Prairie. You'll get to meet him and his girlfriend, Katie, at my installation. Along with all of the possibilities I could imagine here at Rejoice, my son was also a pretty powerful impetus for me to get back to the upper Midwest - to come *home*.

This *gnosis* list - this list of learning experiences - barely scratches the surface of my life. Plus it continues as I'm in the last year of my Doctor of Ministry degree. Yet, my life has been rich and full. And, at times, incredibly hard. Yet, I wouldn't trade it for anything because through it all I've also gotten to *know* God. Deeply.

That's why I'm in ministry - to share my *gnosis* of God with you. And to hear about your experience of God. So that we might grow together and lean fully into being the joyful people of God that we are called to be. In Clearwater. Minnesota.

I can't wait to see what God does with us. And I am thankful to you - and to God - for this new opportunity to gain even more *gnosis*. I hope you'll join me.

## Angels Of Maintenance/ Property Committee



During the last month the Property Committee has been actively working on the following projects:

- **Food Shelf:** In September of 2021 Rejoice sold one acre of land to the Clearwater – Clear Lake Food Shelf. Today, I attended the groundbreaking for the new Food Shelf building on that property. For many years Rejoice has been an active partner in support of the Food Shelf, contributing our time, talents, and money. The Food Shelf meets a critical need for the food insecure in our community.
- **Solar Panels:** Rejoice has received a proposal from Wolf River Electric for the installation of solar panels. This proposal offers investment tax credits, Excell Energy incentives, and donations for solar panel installation with very little cash out lay, and a payback withing 1.5 years. The committee is currently reviewing the proposal.
- **Memorial Garden:** The property committee is working on a plan for a Memorial Garden. A memorial garden is a beautifully landscaped outdoor space created for placement of cremated remains in biodegradable containers. It is considered a sacred place set aside for proper interment, memorialization, and perpetual care of our church members and loved ones. A peaceful setting for reflection as a tribute to honor the life of a loved one. The garden would provide a place for loved ones to pray, meditate, and find serenity and solace.
- **Children’s Play Area:** For a very long time the children’s play area has been badly in need of attention. During the last month the Property Committee has focused on making Rejoice a more welcoming place for children. The children’s play sets (2) have been combined into one large set. Both playsets have been pressure washed, painted, and repaired. The play area inside the fence has been cleaned up and a fire pit ring installed. And finally, we sprayed the poison ivy growing in the tree line behind the play area.
- **Furnace Motor Repaired:** The furnace that supports the kitchen area was kicking the circuit breaker out. Thanks go out to our furnace repair crew who replaced the fan motor.
- **Service:** Are you looking for a place / opportunity to serve? The Angels of Maintenance has something for everyone:
  - A strike force of cleaners who show up after large events to clean up. This would be a short-term commitment that reoccurs depending upon what events are happening and when the contract cleaners are scheduled.
  - Did you know that Rejoice has an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)? This is a portable medical device designed for emergency treatment of sudden cardiac arrest. We need an individual trained in the use and maintenance of this equipment.
  - The sign in front of the church is very much in need of an upgrade. We have a sign concept that is in the works. We could use someone to focus on this project and plan for completion.
